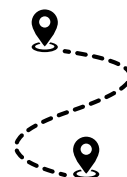

GATE INFORMATION

EAST GATE

The East Gate, also known as the Jog Rd Gate, is staffed by a security guard 24 hours a day. Residents and guests may enter through this gate, which is closest to Section 1. Commercial vehicles are **not** permitted to use the East Gate.



WEST GATE

The West Gate, also known as the Hagen Ranch Gate, is staffed by a security guard for guest access from 8:00 AM to midnight. The resident lane remains open 24/7 for vehicles with a valid barcode. **All commercial vehicles must enter through the West Gate during guest hours.**

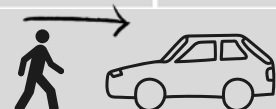

FIXED BUS ROUTE (PALM TRAN ROUTE 81):

There are 16 bus stops along S. Oriole and Gateway. Bus passes can be purchased online and at all PBC libraries. Cash Fare is also accepted (\$2). Half/Reduced fare is available for those that qualify. Buses are equipped with ramps and wheelchair securement devices.

OUR CITIZEN OBSERVER PATROL UNIT NEEDS YOUR HELP!

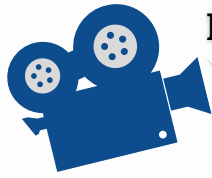
The men and women of our unit are proud of their service to Huntington Lakes. We are actively seeking volunteers to join our team! To explain further, C.O.P. stands for Civilian Observer Patrol, a Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office volunteer program. And the name tells you just what our volunteers do...Our volunteers observe and report to 9-1-1 anything that seems to need the attention of the Sheriff's Department. Examples include suspicious persons, vehicle accidents, property found, graffiti, and more.

REQUIREMENTS:

If you'd like to become a part of this rewarding and productive community unit, the process is rather simple: You will need to attend basics 1 and 2 (2 full days), one half-day of computer class, and then field training – usually up to 4 half-day sessions. Once you've completed your training, you'll be issued a uniform shirt and any other equipment you might need for a specialty unit – radio, bicycle, etc.

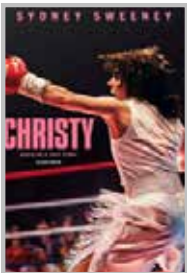

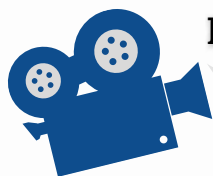

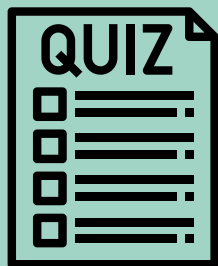

FITNESS GUIDELINES

- Fitness registration will open on the third Thursday of each month at 1:30 PM.
- Classes are subject to change. We will provide notice as far in advance as possible.
- Residents must be registered for the class prior to attendance. You may register online at www.totalhealthsystemsinc.com or use the Total Health Systems App.
- Bring a towel & water bottle to every class. Pool shoes are required for all pool classes. If the class requires additional materials, it will be listed on the THS App.
- Classes that include chairs are marked with a chair icon (🪑). Chair classes are for seated exercises only, not balancing while standing.
- Check with your physician before starting any exercise regimen.

ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

- All class participants must show their Clubhouse ID to the staff member at check-in before every class. This is required each time, for every class.
- If you reserve a spot in a class but do not attend and fail to cancel beforehand, you will be marked as a “No Show.” After three No Shows, you will be suspended from attending classes for one week in the following month.
- Cancellations made less than 45 minutes before the class start time will be considered a late cancellation. Six late cancellations will result in a one week suspension.
- It is your responsibility to cancel any classes you cannot attend. Cancellations can be made online through the THS app, or by calling THS at (561) 962-4344.



SAFETY GUIDELINES

- All class participants must be present and ready to begin at the start of class. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter or join once class has begun, as joining after warmup has started poses a safety risk. We encourage all participants to arrive at least 15 minutes early whenever possible.
- All residents must vacate the room between classes to allow the janitorial crew time to prepare the space for the next activity. To minimize safety risks while furniture is being moved, the room must be completely empty before setup can begin. We kindly ask that residents continue personal conversations outside the room so classes can remain on schedule.
- When waiting to enter a class in the Ballroom, all residents must remain in the Lower Lobby until the room is ready. For the safety of all residents, those who wish to line up along the rail are reminded that ramps must remain clear and unobstructed at all times.

All About GateAccess: The Program



What is GateAccess?

When you call the automated gate number (561-498-1220) to add a visitor, you are using the GateAccess system by ABDI. Each verified owner and tenant has an account identified by a 5-digit PIN, along with their building and apartment number, which gate guards use to verify and log visitors entering HLI. Residents can add guests through the call-in system, the GateAccess.net website, or the mobile app. The PIN is used for calling in guests, logging into the system, and confirming your identity with the office, and it should be kept confidential at all times.

A recent update has eliminated the need to manually enter your PIN when calling from a phone number linked to your account, as the system will now recognize you automatically. However, you may still need to enter your PIN if you are calling from an unregistered number, if your lease has expired and access is suspended pending an updated Certificate of Approval (COA), or if you own multiple units and must use a specific PIN for the unit you are calling for.

All About GateAccess: Types of Guests



TEMPORARY

Temporary guests are authorized by residents to visit for a short period of time. They are called in using the **(561) 498-1220** voicemail system, entered into the GateAccess.net app or website with a start and end date by the resident.

Examples:

- Friends or family visiting for a short period of time or once in a while.
- Taxi services like Uber and Lyft.
- Food deliveries, shipments of furniture, etc.
- Repair companies (A/C, painters, etc.)

Limitations:

- Temporary guests are only authorized to enter the community for up to a week at a time. Once the week expires, if they still require entry, they must be called in again.
- Vendors (repair companies, etc.) cannot be added to your permanent list and must be called in each time they visit for up to a week at a time.
- Vendors, repair companies, etc. are only allowed to enter through the West Gate entrance, also known as the Hagan Ranch Gate.

PERMANENT

Permanent guests are authorized by residents to have access with a start date and no end date. They are added to your list by HLI office staff or entered into the GateAccess.net app or website by the resident.

Examples:

- Family and friends who visit all the time.
- Medical services or verified medical personnel with valid credentials



WAS YOUR GUEST DENIED ENTRY TO THE COMMUNITY?

Here at HLI, both of our gate entrances are manned by security guards who check the IDs of every visitor and verify their destination before allowing them in for your protection. Our Jog Road gate is manned 24/7 while the Hagan Ranch gate is manned 8 AM to midnight. While the security guards are here to protect us, we need to ensure they have the correct information to do their job properly. Here are a few reasons your visitor may have been denied entry at the gate.

- They did not have the required photo identification with them or it is expired (Ex: Driver's license, valid medical credentials, company ID, etc).
- They did not have your complete or correct address. We recommend giving visitors your building and apartment number prior to arriving at the gate. Many visitors only know the name and building address of the person they are visiting. For accuracy, make sure your guest tells the guard your building and apartment number and has their photo ID in hand. Providing this information routes the guard directly to your account, allowing them to process your guest quickly and accurately instead of searching through an exhaustive list of similar names to find you.
- You did not call them in or you hung up before prompted by the automated phone system so the voicemail was not saved.
- You did not select "Update Information" after entering your guest into GateAccess.net website/app which saves the entry.

If none of the above reasons apply to your situation, call the HLI Office at (561) 498-0228 for assistance.

All About GateAccess: Do's and Don'ts



DON'TS

DON'T Drive or walk up to the gatehouses to ask guards to put your visitor in. The guards have a read-only view of ABDI (GateAccess) which does not allow them to edit or input any information into the system for guests. It only allows them to read guest lists and listen to voicemails left by residents for visitor access.

DON'T Ask to speak to the guard over the phone if your visitor calls you from their car while at the gate. The guard cannot authorize your visitor if they are not called into the system. Instead, hang up and call them in.

DON'T Drive up to the gate with your visitor following behind you unless you have called them in. All visitors must be called in before they attempt to enter the community.

DON'T Call the HLI Office staff to ask them to call someone in for you. We can add permanent guests only after verification and approval. Temporary visitors must be added by you via the call-in system, the GateAccess app or website.

DO'S

DO Use the call-in number to add your temporary visitors **before** their arrival so the system has time to log the entry. While it should only take up to a minute for the voicemail to save, you should always try not to cut it too close to their arrival.

DO Use GateAccess.net on your phone, tablet or computer to add temporary and/or permanent guests to your list.

DO Let your visitors know your building and apartment number (Ex: 48-101) and have their photo ID ready to present to the guard at the gate. This will expedite the process.

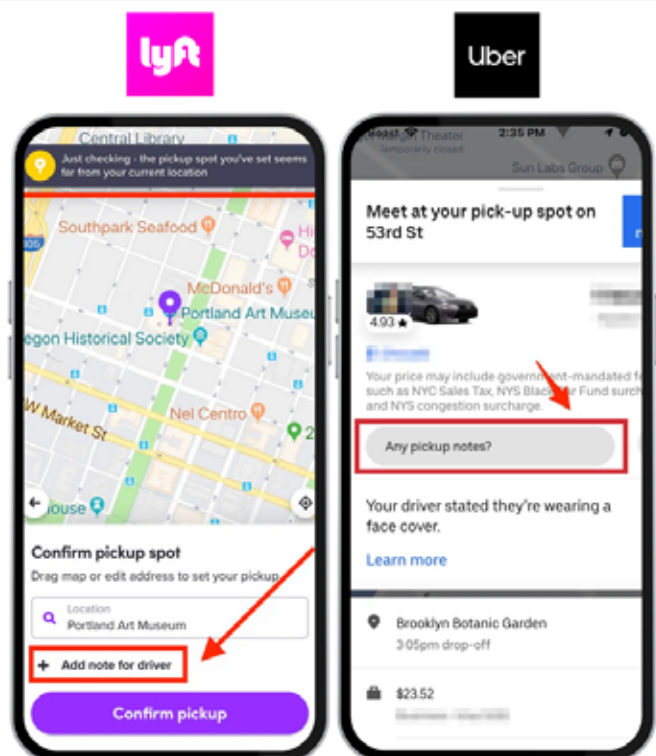
DO Call HLI Office staff for questions and concerns regarding the ABDI GateAccess system.

UBER, LYFT, TAXI AND DELIVERY SERVICES:

Did you know there is a spot when you are scheduling pick-up on the Uber, Lyft, various food, and delivery apps where you can leave notes for the driver? It is in this comment box where you should enter your building and apartment number for ease of access through the gate. We suggest you type in the following message for deliveries and pickup services:

"Please inform the guard at the gate you are picking up for building ____ and apartment ____ and have your ID ready. Thank you."

We have had the issue where an Uber or delivery driver will show up and only have the first name of the person they are visiting and the address to their building. This makes it more difficult for the guards to narrow down the destination which causes delays at the gate and possible entry denial.





HOW TO USE THE CALL-IN SYSTEM

1. Dial: **(561) 498-1220**. The automated call-in system will pick up and should identify your resident file/account by your phone number.
2. You will be prompted to say the name of your guest after the tone. Do this in as quiet an environment as you can. The system "listens" for five seconds of silence after a name is said. If it continues to pick up background noise, it will take longer to process. For this reason, calling on speakerphone is not recommended.
3. Next, the computer will ask you to **PRESS 1** if you expect your guest today, **PRESS 2** if you expect your guest tomorrow, or **PRESS 3** to approve them for both today AND tomorrow. For any other date, **PRESS 4**. No greater than 7 days at a time.
4. If you pressed **1, 2, or 3**, the system will announce that the guest has been added to your list. You may hang up the phone, or **PRESS 1** and the # sign to add another guest.
5. If you pressed **4** for another date, the system will ask you to enter the month and the # sign. *For example, enter 3# for March. Next, you will be asked to enter the day of arrival followed by the # sign. For example, press 16# for the 16th of the month. Finally, you will enter the year followed by the # sign. For example, you may either enter 2026# or 26# for the year 2026.*

Once verified as a valid date, the system will prompt you for the number of days you wish to clear your guest, followed by the # sign.

For example, 7# will clear the guest for 7 days starting 3/16/2026 (the day you previously deemed the day of arrival). When complete, the system will read back the date and number of days, which you may accept by pressing 1 and the # sign, or reject and try again by pressing 2 and the # sign.

Be advised there is a 7-day cap to the number of days permitted.

PLEASE DO NOT HANG UP THE PHONE UNTIL THE COMPUTER PROMPTS YOU TO DO SO.

6. Your visitor will now be authorized to enter. The message will now be stored in the system for the number of days you have cleared him/her. Upon expiration, this guest will no longer appear on your guest list.





HOW TO DOWNLOAD THE APP

1. Navigate to your phone or tablet's app store	 iPhone Google Play Android
2. (1) Find the Search tab (2) Type "GateAccess" in the search bar (3) On your keyboard, press the Enter/Go/Search button (See Figure A on right for guidance) The ABDI GateAccess app will appear next to its icon which is blue and resembles a stop sign. 	FIGURE A 
3. Press "Get" or "Install" depending on your device Once downloaded, select OPEN to proceed.

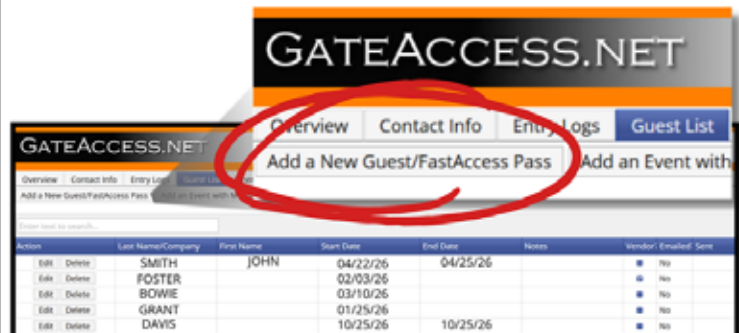
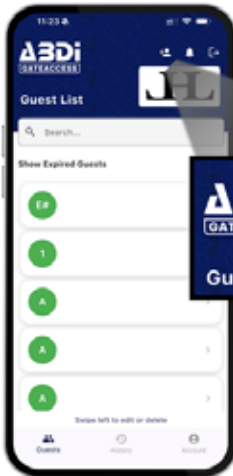


ADDING GUESTS BY COMPUTER, LAPTOP, TABLET AND PHONE ARE ALL SIMILAR

- Once logged into the app, your Guest List will automatically appear. When using the GateAccess website, select the **"Guest List"** tab to open list.



- On the app, a Guest's name can be added by pressing the person icon in the upper right of the screen. On the website, your current Guest List will appear and can be edited from this screen. To add a new guest, select the **"Add Guest"** on app or **"Add a New Guest/FastAccess Pass"**.



- If using the website (app instructions on the next page):
Enter the name of the Guest or Vendor (in the fields shown below)
 - For **Temporary Guest(s)/Vendor(s)**, select a **Start Date** and **End Date**

3a. If using the app:

- Select **Temporary** or **Permanent** based on guest type
- Enter the first and last name of the guest
- Vendor/Company name can be added to the "Last Name" field
- If guest access is **Temporary**, select a start and end date.
- Once all applicable fields are complete, select **Add Guest** or **Save** (located in upper right corner)
- A **FastAccess Pass** will be generated and can be sent to the newly added guest via text message or email. The FastAccess Pass includes a QR code that can be scanned at the security gate(s) for quick and convenient entry.
